COMPETITION ENTRIES

- The Modelling Competition is open to all Guild members, and takes place at Guildex in Telford on Saturday 4 September 2010.
- Entry is by completing a competition entry form. Both parts of the form must be completed. You may submit more than one entry, but each entry must have a separate form. Photocopies are acceptable, and forms may also be downloaded from the Guild web site at www.gauge0guild.com. Illegible or incomplete forms will not be accepted.
- Entry forms only (not models) must be sent to arrive not later than Saturday 21 August to Nick Dunhill, 16 Bradley Street, Sheffield, S10 1PB. Late entries will be accepted at the discretion of the competition organiser.
- Please advise the competition organiser in advance of unusually large models, such as rakes of coaches, complete trains, scenic models, etc. This is for planning the competition space, and failure to do so may result in the entry being refused.
- Models entered in the competition must be brought to the competition stand not later than 11.00 am. Models cannot be accepted after this time. Models must remain on the competition stand until 4.00 pm, and must be collected before the close of the exhibition. Please be at the competition stand at 4.00 pm for the award of prizes.
- You are advised that the competition stand will be stewarded during the day of the competition. However, the Guild does not insure your models during transit to and from the exhibition. You may wish to make separate arrangements for this.

COMPETITION CLASSES AND AWARDS

- There are three competition classes:
 - A: Locomotives**, steam, diesel, and electrically-powered prototypes
 - B: Rolling stock including self-powered railcars and multiple units**
 - C: Scenery**
- First, second, and third prizes will be awarded in each class.
- In addition, an award will be given to the best entry from a novice builder in any class. This must be your first attempt at 7mm modeling.

JUDGING

- Judging will be by a ballot of exhibition visitors. Complete a ballot form by nominating the model in each class that, in your opinion, best represents high quality modeling, and place your form in the ballot box provided on the competition stand.
- Judging will begin at 11.00 am and finish at 2.00 pm.
- The results will be announced and prizes awarded at 4.00 pm at the competition stand.
